1. Dr. Omobola Johnson Named To World Wide Web Foundation Board

After a 3-year tenure as an Honorary Chairperson of the Alliance for Affordable Internet (A4AI) where she provided guidance and advocacy to help drive down internet costs, Dr. Omobola Johnson is joining the Web Wide Web Foundation as a board member.

2. Nigeria-China Trade Value Reaches \$7.2 Billion [January 2018 – June 2018]

The China Commercial Consular to Nigeria, Mr. Hongliang Gao, has put the present value of trade between Nigeria and China at \$7.2 billion, making China the third largest trading partner with Nigeria.

At the opening ceremony of the 2018 China-Nigeria Trade Fair in Lagos, Mr. Gao stated:

"Nigeria is Africa's first population country and the largest economy. It is rich in natural resources, fertile land and huge market potential. In recent years, the friendship between China and Nigeria have been further strengthened, high-level exchanges have become closer, political mutual trust has deepened, bilateral economic and trade cooperation have achieved fruitful results, and the scale of trade has continued to expand.

From January to June this year, the bilateral trade volume between China and Nigeria reached \$7.2 billion. It increased by 7. 6 per cent year-on-year.

At present, Nigeria is China's third largest trading partner in Africa, the largest engineering contracting market and an important investment destination.

The continuous and in-depth development of China-Nigeria economic and trade relations is in the common interest of the two peoples."
